Entry Fees:

Squaw Creek will be asked to let The Colony Bass Club Members fish at a discounted rate on a future date.

This event will be open to the public. But a max of 200 anglers may fish.

The Colony will try to donate the stage for the weigh in. David Blackstock has a large tank to use at weigh in as well.
